

PRINT AND CUT: WATER CYCLE DEFINITIONS

EVAPORATION Heat from the sun makes water rise up.	CONDENSATION Was once a gas but then changed into a liquid able to be seen.	CLOUD Water vapor in the sky. We refer to them as cumulus, stratus, and cirrus.
PRECIPITATION Falls down as a crystal, drip, or even a ball	RIVER A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, a lake, or another such stream.	INFILTRATION Movement of water into the ground from the surface.
GROUND WATER Is beneath the surface of the ground in the zone of saturation where every pore space between rock and soil particles is saturated with water.	EVAPOTRANSPIRATION Water evaporated from plants.	WATER CYCLE Movement of water into the ground from the surface.
