

2018 CSLP Annual Meeting Recap

April 9 – 12, 2018

Denver, Colorado



The 2018 CSLP Annual Meeting was held at the Westin Downtown Denver, Colorado on April 9 -12, 2018 and attended by 82 librarians from the United States, District of Colombia, Mariana Islands, American Samoa, Bermuda, Guam, and the Federated States of Micronesia.

At this meeting, the group typically makes the major decisions of the organization under the direction of the Board of Directors and the Organizational Coordinator, Luke Kralik. Some of the decisions that were finalized at this Annual Meeting included:

CSLP is working to have planning begin earlier to allow more time to fine tune the programs and to match the themes and slogans with the artists.

One big change that will be occurring in regards to the CSLP Annual Meetings will be that they will move to the fall rather than the spring therefore there will be an 18-month gap between the 2018 and the 2019 Annual Meeting. More communication will be sent to the CSLP State Representatives to keep them apprised of decision made between these two meetings. The dates and location for the 2019 CSLP Annual Meeting will be September 16-19, 2019 at the Westin Downtown Indianapolis, Indiana.
